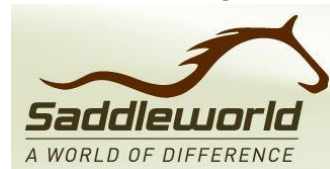

HALTER CLASSES CONT.....

Entry fee for classes C1 to C4 is \$5.00 per entry for QPHA Inc. members or \$6.00 for non-QPHA Inc. Members, per class, not for each horse entered in the class.

- C1 **Double Registered Pinto** (not including any other pinto association; copy of registration papers from breed society to be included with entries e.g. Paint, Part Arab, ASH etc.).
- C2 **Owners Group of Two Pintos** (Pintos need not be related, but must be owned by one owner and registered as a pinto).
- C3 **Sire's or Dam's Progeny** (minimum of 2 progeny and a maximum of 3 progeny by the SAME SIRE OR DAM to be shown in this class. Sire OR Dam need not be Pinto, but resulting progeny being shown in this class MUST be registered Pintos).
- C4 **Sire or Dam & Progeny** (Sire or Dam and a minimum of 1 progeny and a maximum of 2 progeny to be shown in this class. All horses must be registered Pintos).

IN HAND & HANDLER CLASSES

(to be judged after halter classes)

- C5 Western Youth Showmanship at Halter (HSAA) (18years and under)
- C6 Western Adult Showmanship at Halter (HSAA)
- C7 Youth English Handler 17 years and under (Horses 3 years and over to be bridled, horses 2 years and under to be in a halter)
- C8 Adult English Handler 18 years and over (Horses 3 years and over to be bridled, Horses 2 years and under to be in a halter)
- C9 Hunter In Hand Open (HSAA) (Junior Horse to be in plain leather halter. Horses 3 years and over to be in a plain bridle. Handler attire – plain polo or plain collared shirt. Trousers - no jeans. Jodphur boots or runners. Hat, tie and gloves optional).

RIDDEN EVENTS

- C14 Smartest on Parade – ENGLISH, WESTERN OR AUSTRALIAN STOCK HORSE ATTIRE **Youth Rider 17 years & under** - judged on dress of rider and presentation of horse which is most pleasing & catches the judge's eye. **Does not include a workout.**
- C15 Smartest on Parade – ENGLISH, WESTERN OR AUSTRALIAN STOCK HORSE ATTIRE **Adult rider 18 years & over** - judged on dress of rider and presentation of horse which is most pleasing & catches the judge's eye. **Does not include a workout.**

DRESSAGE

Dressage arena will be set up on the main oval and will be open from 10am-1pm.

- D1 Preparatory 2 (Walk Trot)
- D2 Preliminary 1C
- D3 Novice 2B

WESTERN PERFORMANCE CLASSES

(HSAA rules and attire must be worn – long sleeved shirt, long pants, western hat or helmet, leather halter, no chain for led trail).

- C16 Maiden Horse, Western Pleasure, may be shown in snaffle bit.
- C17 Western Pleasure, Horse 3 years & over
- C18 Western Horsemanship, Horse 3 years & over
- C19 Maiden Horse, Ridden Trail, Horse 3 years & over, may be shown in snaffle bit.
- C20 Ridden Trail, Horse 3 years and over
- C21 Led Trail (open to all unbroken horses 2 years and under and miniatures any age only).

HI-POINT WESTERN PINTO

PINTO UNDER SADDLE CLASSES

Horses in Pinto under Saddle classes can be ridden in English, Western or Australian Stock Horse attire.

LIST OF DEFINITIONS

Age of Horse	The age of the horse is to be calculated as at 1 st August
Horse Age for Saddle Classes	Pintos entered in saddle classes must be 3 years old or older.
Junior Horse Age for Saddle Classes	3 to 5 years old
Senior Horse Age for Saddle Classes	6 years old & older
Stallions not exc 14hh	Are allowed to be shown in halter/led classes and ridden classes by a Youth 14 years and over. Stallion must be under the control of a competent handler/rider at all times.
Stallion exc 14hh	Are allowed to be shown in halter/led classes and ridden classes by a Adult 18 years and over. Stallion must be under the control of a competent handler/rider at all times.
Stallions any height	Are eligible for all saddle classes where applicable excluding Youth classes
Youth classes	No stallions allowed
Youth Age for HSAA Classes	Age is calculated as age on the 1 st August. If aged 19 on the 1 st August, you cannot compete in Youth classes.
Youth Hack English	18 years and under
HSAA Performance Classes	HSAA events are conducted under HSAA rules. Correct attire, equipment and rein handling applies. Junior horses competing in western classes can be ridden 2 handed in a snaffle or hackamore or 1 handed in a curb bit. Senior horses competing in western classes must be ridden 1 handed using a curb bit. Exhibitors must wear long sleeved shirt, long pants and western hat or helmet in western and trail events.
Maiden Hack/Horse	A maiden is a horse that has not won a first place prize as a hack or in that event.
Dressage classes	Will be run as per Equestrian Australia rules. Max 2 classes per horse over 2 consecutive levels.

RULES AND CONDITIONS OF ENTRY

1. The QPHA Inc. Show Committee reserves the right to alter the program if necessary. Classes may be combined if there are insufficient entries in any classes.
2. All exhibits MUST be adult registered or foal recorded with a pinto association. Photocopy of registration papers MUST be provided if NOT registered with the QPHA Inc.
3. All owners of exhibits entered to compete MUST be financial members with their respective pinto association. Photocopy of membership MUST be provided if NOT a QPHA Inc. member.
4. The QPHA Inc. assumes no responsibility for injury or damage to livestock, person or property of any owner, competitor or assistant. Each participant by the act of their entry waive all claim on the QPHA Inc. and its members.
5. Any person that harasses a Judge or Steward shall be deemed guilty of unseemly conduct and may be disqualified for the remainder of the show with all awards forfeited.
6. The QPHA Inc. Show Committee reserves the right to measure any horse competing in classes with height stipulations.
7. Protests must be made in writing, accompanied by \$50.00 cash and be in the hands of a member of the show committee no later than 15 minutes after the completion of the class concerned. Should the grounds for protest be considered frivolous, this money will be forfeited.
8. All competitors in sporting events must wear an approved safety helmet.
9. All persons in the ring must wear appropriate footwear and headgear. All riders aged 18 years and under must wear an approved safety helmet at all times mounted (including western).
10. All horses entered that are not registered with QPHA Inc. MUST comply with QPHA Inc. Colour and Breed requirements.
11. Animal welfare rules apply to this event as per EA/HSAA regulations. Any handler that mistreats his/her horse may be disqualified for the remainder of the show with all awards forfeited.
12. Insurance regulations require that ALL exhibitors and riders who are NOT members with either the QPHA Inc, EA or an EA affiliated club must pay day insurance of \$20 and sign a disclaimer to be able to compete. Please provide proof of membership.
13. There will be NO deviation from the rules including dress attire and equipment for horses.
14. Riders that compete in class C12 cannot compete in C13. Riders that compete in either C12 or C13 cannot compete in any other ridden classes except C14 Smartest on Parade and Fancy Dress. Lead Line & Walk & Trot classes can be ridden in either English or Western attire but not a combination of both.
